

Proposed changes to charges and conditions in council car parks

The council is proposing to make some changes to its car parks to encourage greater use of those that have spare capacity, help tackle the climate emergency and increase income to help pay for vital council services.

The changes being proposed are shown below, each one has an Item Number to correspond with the Off Street Parking Places Notice.
