THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in the Canterbury district:

Valley Road	Barham	Double yellow lines outside the village hall to protect visibility when leaving the car park
Shalmsford Street	Chartham	Yellow lines and a pavement parking ban near the school to control obstructive and inconsiderate parking
Station Road & Church Lane	Chartham	Changes to double yellow lines outside the church
Howfield Lane	Chartham Hatch	Double yellow lines around the bends near the junction with Nightingale Close because of the risk of conflict between parked cars and cars travelling at speed.
Church Lane	Chislet	Disabled Parking Bay outside the school
Blackthorn Road	Hersden	Extend double yellow lines outside Nos 79-85 and No 54 to prevent obstructive parking
Church Road & Nargate Street	Littlebourne	Double yellow lines to keep the junction clear
Church Lane & The Street	Petham	Double yellow lines to keep the junction clear
Cedar Road & Sleigh Road	Sturry	Double yellow lines at the junctions to protect visibility
A2 overbridge	Upper Harbledown	Double yellow lines on A2 overbridge leading to the London bound on-slip, to control parking on the bridge
Grove Ferry Hill & Becketts Wood	Upstreet	Double yellow lines to keep the junction and Becketts Wood clear of parked vehicles
Island Road & Stour Valley Close	Upstreet	Double yellow lines on the north side of Island Road and the west side of Stour Valley Close to maintain the flow of traffic and prevent obstructive parking







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





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


8660: Proposed disabled parking bay Chislet School, Church Lane, Chislet




