Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, City of Canterbury) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following length of road in the Canterbury district:

Gas Street, Canterbury:

Remove a 15 metre long section of the parking bay.

This change is required to support works to improve the entrance to Canterbury Castle.

Full details are contained in the draft order which, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, maps showing the proposals and a copy of the order which will be amended by the proposed order, may be examined online at www.canterbury.gov.uk/consultations.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2024 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Canterbury) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No.8) Order 2024" ("this Order").
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Canterbury) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023" ("the Order of 2023") shall have effect as though:
 - (a) Schedule 2 to the Order of 2023 is amended by the issue or replacement of the following Map Tiles:

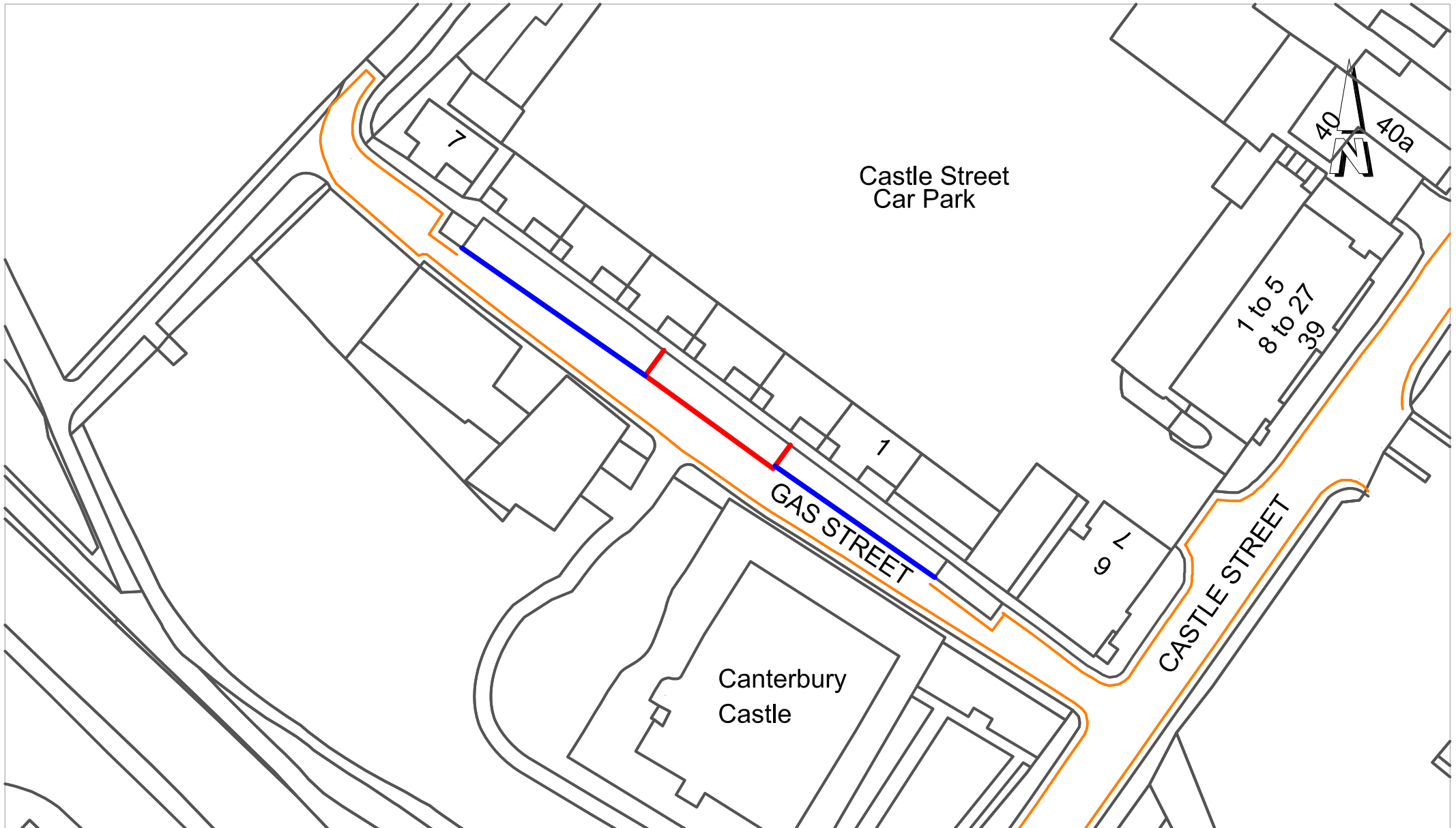
