### The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Canterbury City Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 32 and 35 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, with the consent of Kent County Council under Section 39(3) of the said Act of 1984.

#### **PART A**

The Order relates to the following car parks:

Albin's, Beach Street, Beach Walk, Bisson's, Black Griffin Lane, Castle Row, Castle Street, Chapel Street, Council Offices (Staff and Visitors), Cow Lane, Essex Street, Faversham Road Car Park, Fountain Street, Franklyn House, Sturry, Gladstone Road, Gorrell Tank, Gorrell Valley Nature Reserve Car Park, Hampton Pier, Hawks Lane, Holmans Meadow, Keam's Yard, Kingfisher Close, Kingsmead Leisure Centre, Longport, Market Street, Marlowe Theatre, Maynard Road, Memorial Park Herne Bay, Middle Wall, Millers Field, Neptune, New Dover Road Park and Ride, New Street, Northgate, North Lane, Notley Street, Ocean View, Orange Street, Oyster, Parham Close, Pound Lane, Pound Lane Residents Car Park, Queningate, Reculver Drive, Reculver Towers, Reculver Country Park, Regent Street, Riverside Children's Centre, Rosemary Lane, Rye's, Salt Marsh Lane, St James' Gardens, St John's Lane, St Peter's Grove, St Radigund's, School Lane, Simmonds Road, Shaftesbury Road, Southern Way, Station Road West, Sturry Road Park and Ride, Swalecliffe Avenue, Sydenham Street, Tankerton Road, Tower Way, Toddlers Cove, Victoria Recreation Ground, Victoria Street, Watling Street, Whitefriars, Whitstable Harbour, Whitstable Swimming Pool, William Street, Wincheap Park and Ride, Windsor House and Canterbury Coach Park.

- 1.52 'Park and Ride permit' means a permit which allows the holder to park in Park and Ride car parks and to travel on Park and Ride bus services;
- 1.53 'Park and Ride Corporate Permit' means a permit which allows the holder to create an account allowing employees to park in Park and Ride car parks at a discounted fee and travel on Park and Ride bus services;

## THE CANTERBURY CITY COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025

**Draft Order** 

#### The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2025

The Canterbury City Council (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of powers contained in Sections 32 and 35 of and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers in that behalf and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- 1. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:
- 1.01 'Accommodation Permit Canterbury' means a concessionary permit for use in any of the Council's car parks in Canterbury, except Watling Street and the Park and Ride car parks, to provide parking for 24 hours at the cost defined in Part 1 of the Second Schedule (inclusive of VAT), subject to a minimum purchase of 5 permits, available only to proprietors of hotels, guest houses and accommodation available for short term holiday lets on a serviced or self-catering basis within the city centre of Canterbury as approved by the Head of Transportation and Environment; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.02 'Accommodation Permit Herne Bay' means a concessionary permit for use in Beach Street and Market Street car parks to provide parking for 24 hours at the cost defined in Part 2 of the Second Schedule (inclusive of VAT) subject to a minimum purchase of 5 permits, available only to proprietors of hotels, guest houses and accommodation available for short term holiday lets on a serviced or self-catering basis within Herne Bay as approved by the Head of Transportation and Environment; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.03 'Accommodation Permit Whitstable' means a concessionary permit for use in Gorrell Tank, Keam's Yard, Middle Wall and Victoria Street car parks to provide parking for 24 hours at the cost defined in Part 3 of the Second Schedule (inclusive of VAT), subject to a minimum purchase of 5 permits, available only to proprietors of hotels, guest houses and accommodation available for short term holiday lets on a serviced or self-catering basis within Whitstable as approved by the Head of Transportation and Environment; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.04 'ANPR' means a payment system in car parks that uses Automatic Number Plate Recognition technology to record vehicles entry and exit times and calculate the appropriate charges required to be paid.
- 1.05 'Appropriate Manner' in relation to the display of prepaid tickets and permits means in such a position:
- (a) inside the vehicle and in such a manner that date and time symbols or permit details thereon are clearly visible from the front or near side of the vehicle;
- (b) attached to a trailer around a beam as close to the towing hitch as possible;
- 1.06 "Autopay Account" means a system of registering the vehicle with the Council for the purpose of paying for parking by bank debit.
- 1.07 'Barrier controlled car park' means a car park whereby access into and out of the car park is controlled by barriers linked to pay stations or another payment system.
- 1.08 'Blue Badge' shall mean a badge issued under the provisions for parking concessions for disabled people as provided by the Department of Transport;
- 1.09 'Boat Trailer' means a trailer as defined in the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986, which has been constructed or adapted solely for the purposes of carrying a boat or personal water craft;
- 1.10 'Business User's Parking Bay' means a bay marked with white lines onto the surface of a parking place and marked with appropriate signage which is reserved for the use of holders of Business Users' reserved space parking permits only;
- 1.11 'Canterbury Business User's Permit' means a permit available to people who work within the

Canterbury City Centre zone and who can prove that they regularly need to use their vehicle during the working day for the purposes of their work or the business of their employer to park in any of the Council's car parks in Canterbury except North Lane, Pound Lane, Queningate, Castle Street and Watling Street car parks at the fee described in the Second Schedule, improper use of which will render the permit void;

- 1.12 'Canterbury Business User's Reserved Space Permit' means a permit available to people who work within the Canterbury City Centre zone and who can prove that they regularly need to use their vehicle during the working day for the purposes of their work or the business of their employer, to park their vehicle in St John's Lane car park and also in the bays marked for that purpose in Pound Lane, Rosemary Lane and St Radigund's car parks at the fee described in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.13 'Canterbury Resident's Off-Street Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability, proof of residency, a copy of a valid full driving licence; a vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle and if the vehicle is not owned by the applicant, the written consent of the owners, for residents who live in the vicinity of the car park for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Canterbury, belonging to the Council, except for Castle Street, Queningate, Watling Street, Whitefriars and the Park and Ride car parks, at any time, obtainable from the Council at the fee described in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void. Where a property address has off street parking provision, a residents' off-street permit may not always be issued to an applicant from that address:
- 1.14 'Canterbury Resident's Limited Off Street Permit' means a permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability, proof of residency, a copy of a valid full driving licence; a vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle and if the vehicle is not owned by the applicant, the written consent of the owners, for residents who live in the vicinity of the car park for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Canterbury, belonging to the Council, except for Watling Street, Castle Street, Whitefriars and the Park and Ride car parks between the hours of 5pm on one day and 9am on the next and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, obtainable from the Council at the fee described in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.15 'Car' means the same as motor car;
- 1.16 'Caravan' means a trailer constructed to include living accommodation and equipment;
- 1.17 'Charge Certificate' is a notice issued by the Council to a motorist who has received a Penalty Charge Notice and subsequent Notice to Owner but has not paid the penalty charge within the statutory time limits. A charge certificate increases the full penalty charge by 50%.
- 1.18 'Coach' means a passenger carrying vehicle, exceeding 5.5m in length and capable of carrying more than 16 passengers;
- 1.19 'Commercial Vehicle' means any mechanically propelled vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of goods;
- 1.20 "Council" means Canterbury City Council
- 1.21 'Councillor Parking Permit' means a permit issued to a Councillor of the City Council by the Head of Transportation and Environment for use strictly in the performance of Council business; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.22 'Disabled parking bay' means a bay within a parking place identified by surface markings and or other signage, for the parking at any time of vehicles displaying valid disabled persons' badges only for a maximum period of three hours. Payment is not required for an initial period of three hours, provided that the vehicle has been pre-registered for barrier controlled car parks, after which payment must be made in accordance with charges applicable in that parking place. Payment will not be required in the Orange Street car park, Canterbury and during the day on Mondays to Saturdays in Chapel Street car park, Herne Bay;
- 1.23 'Disabled parking permit' means a permit formerly issued by the Council in exceptional circumstances to those who live and/or work within the district and are either in receipt of Disability

Living Allowance (DLA) (Mobility Component at the Higher Rate) or are over 65 without DLA but with a blue badge and attendance allowance exempting them from the three hour time restriction subject to an administration charge of £12.50 (inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void:

- 1.24 'Disabled Person's Badge' has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000 (as amended);
- 1.25 'Disabled Person's Vehicle' has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (as amended);
- 1.26 'Driver' in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it entered the parking place;
- 1.27 'Electric vehicle' is a car that runs solely on electric power, stored in an on-board battery that is charged from mains electricity;
- 1.28 'Electric vehicle parking bay' means a parking bay reserved for electric vehicles while they are being charged;
- 1.29 'Faith & Community Permit' means a permit for a specified vehicle, for use in a nominated car park, during a specified three hour period each week, available to persons carrying out voluntary activity benefiting the local community, at the fee described in the Second Schedule; this permit is available for use in all pay & display car parks except the Whitstable Harbour Car Park, provided that the vehicle has been pre-registered for barrier controlled car parks; this permit is not available to new applicants;
- 1.30 'Franklyn House Resident's Off-Street permit' means a non-transferable permit available to residents of Franklyn House for the parking of a motor car in Franklyn House Residents' car park;
- 1.31 'Hackney Carriage' means any hackney carriage for the time being licensed by the Council;
- 1.32 'Hawks Lane Reserved Space Permit' means a permit enabling the holder to park their vehicle in a designated space in Hawks Lane car park at the fee described in the Second Schedule, improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.33 'Herne Bay Business User's Permit' means a permit available to people who work in Herne Bay Town centre to park in Memorial Park car park and all town centre Pay and Display car parks in Herne Bay at the fee described in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.34 'Herne Bay Resident's Off —Street Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Herne Bay and School Lane car park in Herne, belonging to the Council, at any time, at the fee described in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.35 'Herne Bay Residents' Off- Street (Limited) Parking Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Herne Bay belonging to the Council and School Lane car park in Herne, between the hours of 5pm on one day and 9am on the next and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.36 'Kingfisher Close Visitor's Permit' means a permit issued to a resident of Kingfisher Close to be displayed in a visitor's vehicle while it is parked in one of the visitors' parking bays
- 1.37 'Leisure Car Park Permit' means a permit enabling the permit holder to park in one of the following car parks free of charge: Bishopstone Lane, Faversham Road, Gorrell Valley Nature Reserve, Hampton Pier, Swalecliffe Avenue, Ocean View or Reculver Drive car park;
- 1.38 'Linear Tariff' means a system of parking payment with a set minimum and maximum payment allowing parking to be paid for by payment of any amount between the minimum and maximum values:
- 1.39 'Marked Bay' means a bay marked on the surface of a parking place within which a vehicle

may park;

- 1.40 'Market Traders' Permit' means a permit for the parking of Market Traders' vehicles in Maynard Road car park, Canterbury on Wednesdays or Fridays only free of charge; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.41 'Marlowe Theatre Stage Door Permit' means a permit issued by the staff at the Marlowe Theatre to vehicles associated with the theatre or productions therein which are parked in the Marlowe Theatre car park;
- 1.42 'Military Road Visitor Car Park Permit' means a permit issued by City Council staff to visitors to the Council Offices allowing the holder to park in the Council Offices Visitor Car Park, Military Road
- 1.43 'Minibus' means a small passenger carrying motor vehicle not exceeding 5.5m in length capable of carrying more than eight but not more than 16 passengers whether or not the same is either a motor car or a heavy motor car as the case may be;
- 1.44 'Motor Car' means any motor car within the meaning of Section 136(2) of the Act of 1984 with the exception of a commercial vehicle;
- 1.45 'Motor Caravan' means a motor vehicle not exceeding 5.5m in length which provides fixed sleeping arrangements whether or not the same is either a motor car or a heavy motor car as the case may be;
- 1.46 'Motor Cycle' means any vehicle as defined in Section 136(4) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.47 'Motor Cycle Bay' means a parking bay marked out on the surface of the car park that is reserved for the parking of solo motorcycles only;
- 1.48 'Motor Vehicle' means any vehicle as defined in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.49 'Notice to Owner' means a statutory notice served by the Council on the person they believe is the owner of a vehicle against whom they have issued a penalty charge notice that remains unpaid after 28 days.
- 1.50 'Owner' has the same meaning as in the Act of 1984;
- 1.51 'Park and Ride' means a service provided by the Council to park and obtain bus travel to the city centre;
- 1.52 'Park and Ride permit' means a permit which allows the holder to park in Park and Ride car parks and to travel on Park and Ride bus services;
- 1.53 'Park and Ride Corporate Permit' means a permit which allows the holder to create an account allowing employees to park in Park and Ride car parks at a discounted fee and travel on Park and Ride bus services:
- 1.54 'Parking Bay' means a bay marked with white lines on the surface of a parking place within which a vehicle may park;
- 1.55 'Parking Place' means any car park provided by the Council authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place;
- 1.56 'Pay and Display' means a system of payment for parking of motor vehicles used at car parks where pre-paid tickets must be obtained and be displayed in the appropriate manner within the vehicle; such tickets to be non-transferrable to any other vehicle or car park;
- 1.57 'Pay by phone' means a parking payment system enabling payment for parking in car parks to be made by the use of a mobile phone or similar device. A small service fee may be added to the parking fee except in car parks where Pay by phone is the only form of payment accepted
- 1.58 'Pay Station' means the equipment installed at some barrier controlled car parks to enable payment of the appropriate fee to be made;
- 1.59 'Penalty Charge Notice' means a notice issued by the Council to a motorist appearing to be in

charge of a vehicle that the council believe was contravening its traffic regulation order;

- 1.60 'Prepaid Ticket' means a ticket obtained from an automatic ticket issuing machine in pay and display car parks for collecting charges installed at any of the parking places referred to in the Second Schedule hereto:
- 1.61 'Private Light Goods Vehicle' means a motor vehicle as defined in Section 138(3) of the Act of 1984 as a goods vehicle but not exceeding 1.5 tonnes unladen weight or in the alternative as specified in Schedule 1 to this order in relation to certain car parks where different weight requirements apply;
- 1.62 'Proof of residency' means proof that a person is in permanent occupation or continual occupation for a considerable time in relation to a property, that property being the person's settled or usual abode;
- 1.63 'Public Service Vehicle' means a vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers as defined in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;
- 1.64 'Registered Keeper' means the person in whose name the vehicle is registered under the Vehicle (Excise and Registration) Act 1994;
- 1.65 'Release fee' means a charge of £25 (inclusive of VAT) to release a vehicle from any car park out of hours when attended by the Parking Services standby service; the charge for the Castle Street car park to be £50 (inclusive of VAT);
- 1.66 'Relevant Date' means the date upon which any vehicle is or was parked in any parking place referred to in this Order or upon which any event occurs or occurred in breach of any of the provisions of this Order or to which this Order relates;
- 1.67 'Relevant Position' means:

In the case of a disabled person's badge -

The badge must be displayed on top of the dashboard or facia panel of a vehicle with the front of the badge (ie the side showing the wheelchair-user symbol) facing forward so that the relevant details are legible from outside of the vehicle. If the vehicle does not have a dashboard or facia panel you must exhibit the badge in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the relevant details are legible from outside the vehicle.

In the case of any other badge as follows -

- i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
- ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle;

In all cases the details on the front of the badge must be clearly visible for inspection;

- 1.68 'Resident' means a person whose main or principal residence is located within the Canterbury district;
- 1.69 'Residents' car park' means a car park available only for the use of holders of residents' parking permits for the identified car park;
- 1.70 'Residents' Electric Vehicle Overnight Permit' means a permit that allows a resident to park in a designated electric vehicle parking bay in a council car park whilst charging their electric vehicle between the hours of 7pm and 7am daily;
- 1.71 Residents' Parking Permit means a non-transferable permit at the fee described in the second Schedule to this Order, issued to residents who live in the vicinity of a specified residents' car park and who have no off-street parking provision associated with their property nor an on street parking permit issued to their property, for the parking of a motor car in the specified residents' car park; improper use of which will render the permit void. The number of permits issued per household will be entirely at the Council's discretion;

- 1.72 'Resident's Rate' means the parking charge payable by a Resident who holds an account for automatic payment of charges in ANPR car parks;
- 1.73 'Solo Motor Cycle' means a motor bicycle without a sidecar or trailer;
- 1.74 'St James' Gardens Car Park Permit' means a permit allowing the holder to park in St James' Gardens Car Park;
- 1.75 'Station Road West car park rail user permit' means a permit available from the City Council, subject to availability, for rail season ticket holders to park their vehicle on Mondays to Fridays in Station Road West car park at the fee described in the Second Schedule to this Order, improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.76 'Tankerton Road Resident's Permit' means a non-transferable permit, at the fee described in the Second Schedule to this Order, allowing a resident living in the vicinity of Tankerton Road car park to park in that car park;
- 1.77 'Taxi Driver's Electric Vehicle Overnight Permit' means a permit that allows the owner of a licensed taxi or private hire vehicle to park in a designated electric vehicle parking bay in a council car park whilst charging their electric vehicle between the hours of 7pm and 7am daily;
- 1.78 'Temporary Car Parking Permit' means a permit issued by the Head of Transportation and Environment for parking requirements of guests or visitors to the City Council or to those given special authorisation by it; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.79 'Trailer' means a trailer as defined in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.80 'Valid Pay and Display ticket' means a ticket issued from an automatic ticket issuing machine within a Pay and Display car park, that shows the time the ticket was purchased, expiry date and time, registration index number of the vehicle, the fee paid and the machine number, such tickets to be non-transferable to another car or used in another car park;
- 1.81 'Whitstable Business User's Permit' means a permit available to people who work in Whitstable Town centre to park in public car parks in Whitstable, with the exception of Whitstable Harbour, Oyster, Beach Walk and Whitstable Swimming Pool car parks, at the cost specified in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.82 'Whitstable Harbour Business Permit' means a permit for the parking of motor vehicles in specified parking bays within the harbour, issued subject to the approval of the Harbour Master and at the cost specified in the Second Schedule; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.83 'Whitstable Harbour Staff Permit' means a permit issued to staff working in the Whitstable Harbour Office allowing them to park in the bays next to the office reserved for that purpose; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.84 'Whitstable Market Trader's Permit' means a permit for the parking of Market Traders' vehicles in Gorrell Tank car park, Whitstable at the cost specified in the Second Schedule: improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.85 'Whitstable Residents' Off Street Parking Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, at the fee described in the Second schedule to this Order, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Whitstable belonging to the Council, with the exception of Whitstable Harbour, Whitstable Swimming Pool, Beach Walk and Oyster car parks, at any time, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.86 'Whitstable Residents' Off Street (Limited) Parking Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, at the fee described in the Second schedule to this Order, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Whitstable belonging to the Council, with the exception of Keam's Yard, Whitstable Harbour, Whitstable Swimming Pool, Beach Walk and Oyster car parks, between the hours of 5pm on one day and 9am on the next and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;

- 1.87 'Windsor House Resident's Permit' means a non-transferable permit available to residents of Windsor House for the parking of a motor car in Windsor House Residents' car park.
- 1.88 'Windsor House Resident's Visitor Permit' means a permit made available to residents for the use of their visitors when parking in Windsor House Residents car park.
- 2. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place or any part thereof when such parking place or part thereof is required for any purpose of the Council or for any purpose authorised by the Council.
- 3. Each of the places specified in the First Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such vehicles or classes of vehicles in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that parking place in the said Schedule.
- 4. Where, in the First Schedule to this Order, a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, or during a specified period (including any provisions specifying particular positions or periods for specified classes of vehicle) no vehicle shall be parked in that parking place otherwise than in strict accordance with such provisions.
- 5. No vehicle shall be left in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the First Schedule to this Order in relation to that parking place.
- 6. No vehicle shall be parked in an Electric vehicle parking bay unless it is being charged by means of the provided charging point. This article does not apply if the charging point has been covered up because it is out of order.
- 7. No parking place or any part thereof shall be used when such parking place or part thereof has been closed by the Council in accordance with Article 2 hereof.
- 8. No Hackney Carriage shall use a parking place unless approved by the Head of Transportation and Environment.
- 9. No vehicle shall use a parking place unless there is, in relation to the use of that vehicle by any person who drives it within that parking place, such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988.
- 10. Where, in a parking place, signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose
- of: (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
- (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place;

no vehicle may be driven:

- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated; or
- (ii) in a direction other than that specified;

as the case may be.

- 11. No vehicle shall park on any yellow line within a car park nor cause any obstruction.
- 12. Except in accordance with any right of way which may exist or with the prior written permission of the Council or of any person duly authorised by the Council:
- (a) no parking place may be used as a means of passage for proceeding from one road to another road;
- (b) no vehicle may be driven in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place, changing its position in the parking place or departing from the parking place.

- 13. The engine of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall be stopped as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and the engine shall not be started except when the position of the vehicle in the parking place is about to be changed or the vehicle is about to depart from the parking place.
- 14. No horn or other similar instrument may be sounded on a vehicle using a parking place except when the position of the vehicle in the parking place is about to be changed or the vehicle is about to depart from the parking place.
- 15. No vehicle shall be used while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any thing to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of the skill or services of any person PROVIDED ALWAYS that this Article shall not be deemed to prohibit the use of any vehicle in a parking place for or in connection with the sale of any thing or commodity in any case where the prior written consent of the Council has been obtained.
- 16. No vehicle shall be sold, offered, or exhibited for sale whilst it is in a parking place.
- 17. No vehicle left in a parking place may be used for sleeping, camping, eating or cooking purposes.
- 18. No trailer shall use a parking place, unless otherwise stated.
- No minibus or motor caravan shall use a parking place unless otherwise stated.
- 20. Whenever a vehicle occupies any of the parking places mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, excluding any Barrier Controlled car parks, a prepaid ticket or a combination of prepaid tickets shall be purchased when the vehicle enters the said parking place in respect of the period (not being longer than the maximum period permitted in that parking place) during which the vehicle is intended to be parked in that parking place calculated in accordance with the Second Schedule hereto and such prepaid ticket or tickets shall be exhibited on the vehicle in the appropriate manner throughout the said period, (unless a permit is in force in respect of the vehicle) such tickets to be non-transferable to any other vehicle or used in another car park, or unless the 'Pay by Phone' system has been used.
- 21. Where the parking of a vehicle in any parking place is authorised by a prepaid ticket or tickets under the provisions of Article 19 hereof such vehicle shall not be left in the parking place for longer than the period permitted by the prepaid ticket or tickets, such tickets to be non transferable to any other vehicle or used in another car park.
- 22. (1) If there is a contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 3 to 20 inclusive to this Order then, and in any such case, a penalty charge (hereinafter referred to as 'the penalty charge') shall be payable to the Council under and subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, the amount of the Charge being any amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by the Council.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge may have been incurred it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer/Supervisor employed by the Council, to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:
- (a) Vehicle registration number
- (b) Make of vehicle
- (c) Colour of vehicle
- (d) Detailed location of vehicle (for example meter bay number, residents' bay number, name of car park, or other description of parking place)
- (e) Contravention code and description of contravention
- (f) Time of issue
- (g) Date of the contravention and date of issue
- (h) Penalty Charge Notice number

- (i) Civil Enforcement Officer's number
- (j) Civil Enforcement Officer's signature

Provided that the requirements of this paragraph shall not apply to a breach of this Order if the vehicle is removed from the parking place before the notice can be completed and affixed to the vehicle and that such Penalty Charge Notice may be challenged by the recipient/registered keeper through an independent appeals tribunal managed by the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or its successor in title.

- (3) Subject to Paragraph (4) hereof the penalty charge shall be paid to the Council in by credit card, cheque, banker's draft, automated telephone service, via the Council's website or postal order in each case crossed and made payable to Canterbury City Council which shall be delivered or sent by post to Canterbury City Council, Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent CT1 1YW on or before the end of a period of 28 days from the day on which the penalty charge was incurred.
- (4) In the event of payment being received by the Council as aforesaid within 14 days of the day on which the penalty charge was incurred (provided that if the fourteenth day falls upon a non-working day the period within which payment of the penalty charge as provided herein shall be extended until 5pm on the next full day on which the Council is open whether or not this date is shown on the notice left on the vehicle indicating that a penalty charge is payable) the amount of the penalty charge shall be reduced to an amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by the Council; the said payment shall be accepted in full settlement of the penalty charge payable under the terms hereof.
- (5) Payment of the penalty charge (whether or not the same is reduced under the provisions of Paragraph (4) hereof) will not exonerate any person from payment of any expenses recoverable in respect of the removal and disposal of the vehicle pursuant to the provisions of Articles 26, 27 and 28 of this Order and any statutory provisions for the time being in force or from any claim to damages which the Council may have in respect of damage incurred in relation to the parking of the vehicle howsoever arising.
- (6) If the penalty charge is not paid after a minimum of 56 days and a Charge Certificate is issued, the penalty charge payable will be increased to an amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by the Council.
- 23. Nothing in Articles 5 or 19 shall apply in respect of a disabled person's vehicle in pay and display car parks which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and relevant clock, set to the time of arrival, issued by any local authority, if the vehicle is left for no longer than three hours without payment being made.
- 24. Nothing in Article 19 shall apply in respect of a motor vehicle which is parked in a section of a parking place with a valid, appropriate permit.
- 25. Nothing in Article 19 shall apply in respect of a motor cycle which is parked in a section of a parking place reserved for the parking of a motor cycle free of charge.
- 26. It is hereby directed under the provisions of paragraph (c) of Sub-section (3) of Section 35A of the Act of 1984 that the provisions of Sub-sections (4) and (6) of Section 47 of the Act of 1984 shall apply to this Order save that references in the said Sub-section to "this section" shall be construed as references to Section 35A of the Act of 1984.
- 27. When a vehicle is left in a parking place contrary to the provisions of the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978 and subject to the appropriate notice being served, the said vehicle may be removed. Similarly, when a vehicle is left in a parking place contrary to the provisions of this Order and subject to any necessary authorisation of the DVLA, the said vehicle may be removed.
- 28. Any person removing a vehicle by virtue of the last preceding Article of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it as aforesaid.
- 29. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 26 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

- 30. Where, in this Order, the hours of operation and/or the maximum period for which a vehicle may wait are stated, no vehicle shall exceed the stated period unless with the written authority of the Head of Transportation and Environment.
- 31. (a) Save as hereinafter provided, a Residents' Parking Permit shall not be assigned or transferred by an Owner to any other person but may be surrendered at any time to the Council when the Owner shall be entitled to receive the refund of a sum representing the full month's unexpired portion of the Residents' Parking Permit, subject to the amount refunded being a minimum of £20 (inclusive of VAT).
- (b) The Council shall be entitled to terminate all rights granted by the Residents' Parking Permit if at any time there is any contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order and in any such circumstances the Owner shall not be entitled to any refund whatsoever without prejudice to any other right of action the Council may have whether under this Order or otherwise.
- (c) Where the owner of a vehicle currently holds a Resident's Parking Permit for a site with barrier controlled access arrangements, an access card to the barrier will be provided by the Council subject to the payment of a £30 deposit. The owner will be responsible for the safe keeping of the said access card, which, if lost or damaged, will render the owner liable for all costs of replacement. The deposit shall be refundable upon the safe return of the said access card.
- (d) Where a person has outstanding Penalty Charge Notices, no permit shall be issued until all debts have been discharged.
- 32. The registered keeper at the relevant date shall, pursuant to the provisions of Section 35A(3)(a) of the Act of 1984, be deemed to be responsible for any contravention of or non-compliance with this Order unless the registered keeper can prove in any proceedings:
- (a) that the registered keeper was neither the owner nor the keeper of the vehicle on the relevant date; or
  - (b) that the vehicle was being used on that date without the consent of the registered keeper;

Provided that the Council shall be entitled to proceed against any other person whom the Council proves to be either the owner or the keeper or the driver of the vehicle at the relevant date instead of the registered keeper.

- 33. The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.
- 34. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 2024 and may be cited as the "Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2024".
