

## Proposed changes to charges and conditions in council car parks

The council is proposing to make a number of changes to its car parks to encourage greater use of car parks that have spare capacity, help tackle the climate emergency and increase income to help pay for vital council services.

All public car parks across the district have been placed into tariff 'bands' to provide greater consistency and make it easier for drivers to make informed choices on where to park.

The changes being proposed are shown below, each one has an Item No. to correspond with the Off Street Parking Places Notice.
